CL: Visitor: \$3 pay and display
M: \$4 pay and display
C, N, W, X: \$3 per day – pay and display
 Lot X is free on weekends
HV: Weekdays: \$2 per hour with \$10 deposit on entry. Deposit reduces throughout day. After 3 p.m. and weekends: \$3 coin entry
D: Weekdays: \$2 per hour up to daily maximum of \$15. After 5 p.m. and weekends: \$3 coin entry
P: \$3 coin entry for St. Jerome's University, Renison College and St. Paul's College; \$1 per hour up to a \$4 daily maximum at Conrad Grebel University College
OV: Clinic visitor parking. \$3 coin entry
UWP: \$3 pay and display
Village Visitor: \$3 pay and display. Located in lot S
